I write to you requesting funding for the Paces Mill/Palisades Rehabilitation Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Cumberland Community Improvement District, located at 1100 Circle 75 Parkway SE, Suite 1000, Atlanta GA 30339. This funding would be used to improve infrastructure, drainage, facilities, and visitor experience at one of the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area's most popular park units. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project is a unique partnership between federal and local authorities where federal public investment has fallen behind private sector investment and growth in the surrounding area.
