Dear Chairman Carter and Ranking Member Wasserman Schultz,


As you begin work on the fiscal year 2024 Military Construction and Veterans Affairs appropriations bill, I urge you to consider providing Community Project Funding for military construction programs at Dobbins Air Reserve Base in Georgia's 11<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.

Dobbins Air Reserve Base has a Civil Engineering Group Administrative Facility project for the 94<sup>th</sup> Civil Engineering Group slated for FY27 of the Future Years Defense Program (FYDP). The funding request of \$12 million would construct an administrative space to replace the current facility and allow for consolidation. The existing space is being renovated for occupancy by the 94<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing and 22<sup>nd</sup> Air Force. If not funded, the planned occupancy of the existing space by the 94<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing and 22<sup>nd</sup> Air Force would leave the Civil Engineering Group with no permanent facility to conduct day to day mission requirements. The unit's training facilities are also located on another portion of the base, requiring personnel to drive to the site in order to process and train personnel.
