Dear Chairman Carter and Ranking Member Wasserman Schultz,


As you begin work on the fiscal year 2024 Military Construction and Veterans Affairs appropriations bill, I urge you to consider providing Community Project Funding for military construction programs at Dobbins Air Reserve Base in Georgia's 11th Congressional District.

Dobbins Air Reserve Base has a Security Forces Facility construction project for the 94th Security Forces slated for FY25 of the Future Years Defense Program (FYDP). As the current facility is too small and would require substantial restoration and modernization updates to meet current functional requirements, the funding request of \$22 million would construct a new facility supporting squadron training, administration, operations, and storage requirements for both base operations and deployable forces. Facility would include classrooms, weapons vault, combat training room, locker rooms and showers. If not funded, the current facility will continue to degrade while maintenance costs increase, the unit would continue to use outdated systems further degrading mission readiness.
