

**Congressman Barry Loudermilk community project funding requests for
fiscal year 2023**

Project name: Kennesaw neighborhood improvements

Funding recipient and address: City of Kennesaw- 2529 J.O. Stephenson Avenue, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144

Requested amount: \$5,000,000

Explanation of request: This funding would go to the City of Kennesaw for various infrastructure improvements throughout Kennesaw. These include resurfacing streets, installing sidewalks, and improving drainage in several low to moderate income neighborhoods. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project is intended to promote an active pedestrian lifestyle by connecting Kennesaw residents to downtown Kennesaw and nearby parks.

Project name: Kennesaw pedestrian bridges

Funding recipient and address: City of Kennesaw- 2529 J.O. Stephenson Avenue, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144

Requested amount: \$250,000

Explanation of request: This project in the City of Kennesaw seeks to replace five expiring pedestrian timber bridges with light weight modular aluminum bridges that will last longer and better promote an active pedestrian lifestyle and downtown business for nearby residents.

Project name: Kennesaw traffic light installation project

Funding recipient and address: City of Kennesaw - 2529 J.O. Stephenson Avenue, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144

Requested amount: \$350,000

Explanation of request: This funding would go to the City of Kennesaw for the installation of a traffic light at the entrance of Swift-Cantrell Park and a major arterial road (Old 41 Hwy). City and County have identified area as needing traffic light after numerous accidents. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project is intended to provide traffic management and enhance public safety in and around the entrance to Swift-Cantrell Park, one of the most popular parks in Cobb County.

Project name: Improvements to crossing at Noonday Creek Trail

Funding recipient and address: Cobb County Department of Transportation – 1890 County Services Pkwy, Marietta, GA 30008

Requested amount: \$2,000,000

Explanation of request: This funding would go to Cobb County to help provide a safe and convenient crossing for pedestrians and cyclists using the Noonday Creek Trail. The project will help extend the multi-modal trail system northwards and minimize the impacts to the wetland and floodplains in the area. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project is intended to safely promote connectivity to key areas in the region.

Project name: Improvements to Cobb County International Airport – McCollum Field

Requested amount: \$15,000,000

Explanation of request: This funding would go to Cobb County Department of Transportation for the Cobb County International Airport – McCollum field to meet safety improvements to accommodate the larger cabin aircraft and to acquire additional land to relocate taxiways in order to meet the current demand for hangar space. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project will provide vital economic development by increasing capacity at a critical regional airport with increased air traffic markets and hangar space markets.

Project name: Security Fencing Protection surrounding Dobbins Air Force Base

Requested amount: \$7,506,000

Vehicular crashes from speeding on a curve in the state highway are damaging the security fencing at Dobbins Air Force Base. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project will help enhance security around Dobbins and increase traffic operational safety.

Project name: Intersection Improvements at Black Acre Trail and Third Army Road

Funding recipient and address: Cobb County Department of Transportation – 1890 County Services Pkwy, Marietta, GA 30008

Requested amount: \$5,000,000

Explanation of request: This funding would go to the Cobb County Department of Transportation to improve the safety and operation of U.S. 41 and Cobb Parkway at a relocated and improved intersection with Black Acre Trail and Third Army Road. The existing interstation is misaligned, has poor vertical and horizontal site distance deficiencies, and is a bottleneck for traffic. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the project will help address safety and operational issues in the area.
