Dear Chairman Womack and Ranking Member Clyburn:

I am requesting funding for the Cobb Parkway Pedestrian Bridge North project in fiscal year 2026.

The funding would be used to construct a pedestrian bridge that crosses over Cobb Parkway to create a safe, elevated crossing for pedestrians over Cobb Parkway a high-volume, eleven-lane state corridor. Cobb Parkway separates The Battery, Atlanta's mixed-use community, and the City of Smyrna. Currently, pedestrians traveling between these destinations are forced to contend with safety challenges and hazards as they cross existing crosswalks. This bridge will not only prevent pedestrian-vehicle accidents but will support the local business and workers in the expanding Cumberland area.
